

Security Measures 2016-17

From September 1, 2016 **all the entrances** to the Massillon school are subject to strict **visual verifications** by school staff.

There are two entrances to the secondary school and a separate entrance to the primary school, in rue Audollent.

Avenue de Grande-Bretagne

This external gate is opened exclusively to students at the following times:

Monday to Friday: 7:30-8:00, 8:50-9:00, 10:55-11:10, 11:55-12:10, 13:50-14:00, 15:55-16:10, 16:55-17:10

Saturdays: the school gate is only opened from 7:45-8:00 for 12th grade students.

Specific cases for access in rue Bansac

- If students are late and arrive after the gate is closed.
- Specific authorization to leave the premises, validated by the 'vie scolaire', to be given to reception upon leaving.
- Special authorization is given if accompanied by an adult outside the school gate opening hours: class lists will be given by the 'vie scolaire'.

Additional measures

- The side gate, which was electronically controlled, will no longer be used.
- An additional gate, **inside the premises**, will be installed at the corner of the new building to ensure the students' security and provide a safer area to gather rather than the pavement in avenue de Grande-Bretagne.
- Except for specific circumstances, cars are now forbidden to access the Massillon north courtyard by avenue de Grande-Bretagne.
- **The area surrounding the entrance gate**, avenue de Grande-Bretagne, **must be kept clear** at all times. Students have been told, especially in the high-school, not to gather in that area, nor around the statue of 'The Poilu'

Rue Bansac

Individual access to Massillon is **compulsory** for families and anyone not working in the school.

For students, only limited access (previously mentioned above) is allowed.

The reception desk, rue Bansac, is opened between 7.45am and 6 pm except during school holidays.

A responsible conduct is the key to guaranteeing the security of the students.
